## A dual mission: education and training

As a public distance-education provider, the CNED, working on behalf of the State, ensures schooling continuity for those students who for any of a variety of reasons, cannot attend classes. It also works with those adults who are setting out on a training path.

- Accessibility: to allow everyone, regardless of their location or situation, the opportunity to receive an education and training.
- Success: to accompany people towards the completion of their projects (getting a diploma, changing trades, finding a job ...).
- Social utility: to effectively ensure the education and training of everyone for individual success and professional integration.



## A provider at the service of public-education and -training policies

Nowadays, the CNED is a player that has committed itself with France's Ministry of National Education in the context of the Ministry's digital plan.

- *D'COL*: a mechanism to offer assistance, support and accompaniment for fifth and sixth graders in priority education, both at school and at home..
- *Languages and digital skills at school*: online mechanism for learning English ("*English for Schools*") and German ("*Deutsch für Schulen*") at school and in colleges.
- *Jules/Devoirs faits* ("*Homework Done*"): conversational agent made available to all middle-schools in France.



## A crucial player in the international development of French

With nearly 32,000 registrants internationally, the CNED is the leading provider of lifelong distance training throughout Europe and the French-speaking world. It is meant for everybody, whether living in France or abroad and regardless of nationality. It offers everyone the possibility to gain, at a distance and on line, a French school or higher education, as well as initial or vocational training. The institution is actively involved in European and international cooperation for the development of distance learning and digital education.

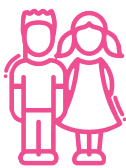
